

IMPORTANT NOTICE

At an Emergency Committee Meeting held at the Club on Wednesday 18th March 2020, in response to the ongoing COVID19 virus and the advice from the Government and Medical Officers, the following was decided.

Unless directed otherwise the Club Bar will remain open for business as usual and meals will continue to be served at lunchtimes and Friday evenings and also the Curry Night scheduled for Thursday 19th March.

However all social events and meetings for the next 12 weeks, or until further notice, are CANCELLED.

This means there will be no Sunday Lunches, Tombola, Quiz Nights, Clubs, Entertainment or private room hire until further notice.

The Meat Draw on Friday 20th and Booze Draw on Sunday 22nd will go ahead as people have already bought tickets but will be suspended after that until further notice.

The AGM due to be held on Thursday 26th March has now been postponed to sometime in the future, this has been agreed by The ACC as a lot of Clubs are in the same predicament.

We feel that we must do something pro active in the current situation especially with the demographics of our members but, we also believe that you all have a choice as to whether to come to the Club or not. We will be taking all necessary hygiene precautions in the bar and kitchen. We just ask that members do the same and wash hands on arrival and not to attend if you have any underlying medical problems or feel unwell with the symptoms of COVID19.
